All participants will abide by current IJF modified rules. No Kansetsuwaza (arm locks) will be allowed. Shimewaza (chokes) will be allowed for 13 years and older. True double elimination will be used for divisions of six or more. Divisions of five or less will be round robin. All divisions will be three minutes in duration using modified IJF scoring rules stated above. The tournament directors reserve the right to make any changes that are in the best interest of the contestants and to achieve fairness in competition. All competitors must have a current USJF, USA Judo, USJA, ATJA or AJJF recognized association membership from other countries. Competitors must present their Judo documentation. Proof of age is required.
